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HELPING KIDS REACH HIGHER

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STAR House Foundation is a non-profit organization based in Roswell, Georgia. We provide out-of-school tutoring and mentoring for at-risk children in our community's Title I schools. During 2021, we served more than 200 students attending Mimosa Elementary, Esther Jackson Elementary, and Vickery Mill Elementary Schools through our afterschool and summer programs. During the first half of the year, we hosted online tutoring sessions for small groups of students, ensuring each student received attention specific to their individual academic needs. In the fall, we returned to school-based after-school programming, however we maintained a low student to teacher ratio to maximize individualized attention for our students. Throughout the year, we continued to take advantage of grant opportunities that provided us with funding to supplement our students' home nutrition. STAR House has continued to serve the needs of the whole child, helping to provide a strong foundation that gives local kids in need the opportunity and support to shoot for the stars.



During the year, STAR House was awarded more than \$50,000 in renewable funding through the American Rescue Plan. The BOOST grant program is administered by the Georgia Statewide Afterschool Network and the Georgia Department of Education and will provide financial support for our efforts to expand and enhance our school-year programs. In addition to supporting our in-house academic and social-emotional interventions, this funding will also greatly increase our ability to contract with highlytrained outside vendors, such as art teachers, yoga instructors, and STEM specialists, to provide on-site enrichment opportunities for our students.
